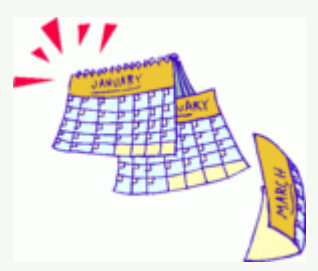
If you have any old school uniform that your children have now grown out of we would be extremely grateful to add it to our uniform shop 😊
